#### MAJOR WORKS ON THE C29 (REGIONAL RTE. 71) - ROAD CLOSURES

This letter is to inform you that North Yorkshire Council, will be undertaking major works at Roebeck Bridge and Black Hills Culvert on the on the C29 (Regional Rte. 71) near Whaw in October and November 2025. Minor works at Mirk Fell Culvert Landslip and surfacing works at Foregill Bridge are also planned.

### Major Works - Roebeck Bridge and Black Hills Culvert

Planned works will require full road closures to enable the works which are planned to involve the replacement of a damaged culvert south of Whaw and strengthening works to Roebeck Bridge, including repair of the collapsed parapet wall. These schemes will ensure serviceability of this key route for communities in Arkengarthdale.

The works are currently programmed to commence in two phases:

- Black Hills Culvert Full road closure on the on the C29 (Regional Rte. 71) between Whaw and Langthwaite from the 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025 for 2 weeks
- Roebeck Bridge Full road closure on the on the C29 (Regional Rte. 71) north of Whaw from 3<sup>rd</sup> November for 3 weeks

Due to the nature of the works requiring excavation of the highway, access during the road closures is not permitted. A plan showing the extent of the works and diversion is enclosed for your information.

Advance warning signage advising of the works will be installed on site shortly. Whilst the works are in progress, a fully signed diversion will be in place.

# Minor Works - Mirk Fell Landslip and Foregill Bridge Surfacing

There are planned works to remediate the landslip at Mirk Fell Culvert, east of Tan Hill on the C29 (Regional Rte. 71). This work has no firm date as of yet but will likely commence in October/November 2025 under 2-way lights. The works will involve repair of the landslip scar and installation of kerbs and drainage.

Surfacing works at Foregill Bridge, Arkle Town are planned to commence in November/December 2025 and will require a full 1 week road closure to enable the surfacing to tie into the existing road. Further communications for this closure will be sent in due course.

A plan showing the locations of the schemes is attached for your information.

Please note, these works are part of an extensive programme and therefore, some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise.

- Please co-operate and comply with any instructions issued by the traffic management operatives and take extra care whilst within the works area.


