# Swaledale and Arkengarthdale

### Coronavirus support

This document is intended to collate all the current information with regard to services available in the two dales to support all residents, particularly those who are self-isolating for whatever reason.

An Anchor Hub has been designated by North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) located at Hudson House in Reeth and managed by Reeth & District Community Transport (RDCT), the Yellow Bus, and Hudson House (HH). This will be managed by Gail Hall and Jill May with the support of the boards of RDCT & HH, and a team of volunteers. The Anchor Hub is expected to remain in operation until at least late September.

#### Anchor Hub

Phone 01748 880 021 manned Monday to Friday 10 am to 3 pm (except bank holidays). Messages can be left at any time. Calls to NYCC from people in the two dales will be redirected to the hub.

The hub will maintain a list of contacts in the various communities in the two dales and will direct callers to their nearest support person.

The hub will also deliver shopping and prescriptions to your door using the Yellow Bus and volunteers.

#### Melbecks (Feetham, Low Row, Blades, Kearton)

In the first instance contact the Anchor Hub at Hudson House or Elizabeth Bedford or Delyth Rennie. See also Reeth below for delivery services from the Post Office, market stalls and Reeth Surgery. Local volunteers can assist with shopping, prescription collection, posting letters etc. Bread from the 2 Dales Bakery in Reeth is delivered on a Thursday. Fruit and vegetables pre-ordered from Colin (see Reeth market below) are brought to Low Row each Saturday and can be collected from the Punch Bowl or Colin can deliver locally if necessary.

# Muker www.mukerorg.com

The Physical Hub in Muker remains the Village Shop which can be used as a drop-off/pick-up point for items (though see below re prescriptions). Their core opening times are Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings 10.00 - 12.00. In addition to this the shop will also be open on a 'pop up' basis, which will be weather dependent. Although the Tea Shop will not be open, a good range of takeaway cakes, sandwiches, hot drinks, light lunches and desserts will be on offer through the Village Store. Daily and Sunday papers will continue to arrive and should be collected from the box outside the shop.

Muker Village Store is continuing their grocery ordering service: as well as their normal groceries they can get bread, meat, fish, fresh fruit and veg, dairy. Place your order on 01748 886409 between 12pm and 3pm Tuesday or by email on <a href="mailto:mukerteashop@btinternet.com">mukerteashop@btinternet.com</a> at any time up until 3pm Tuesday, or by dropping a list through the shop door by 3pm Tuesday. The Farmers Arms has now reopened every day from 11.30am, closed Mondays. For the time being they are using outside seating only. Food is served 12.00 till 2.30pm and 6.00-8.30pm. The lunchtime menu is more or less back to normal, evenings remain themed for now but subject to change as demand changes. No booking required for lunchtimes and tables are on a first come first served basis. Evening meals can be booked or you are welcome to go along and use the outside tables, again first come first served. They are still delivering food within the village and will continue to do so while it remains possible. Hawes Surgery Prescriptions: As restrictions lift, and individuals return to work, it is proposed that this service will only continue (subject to any changes in restrictions going forward) until the end of August (28th August being the last day the collection will take place via this method). After this date, your previous method of prescription delivery/ collection will resume, whether this is collection by you individually or delivery by the service provided by the Hawes practice. When you order your prescription medicines please make it clear to the surgery which delivery/collection method you are using.

We are happy to collect prescriptions for you up to and including 28<sup>th</sup> August. Please ensure that, if you require a prescription to be collected, this is requested via Jackie Pope, so that the collection and distribution can be managed effectively.

If you use **Reeth Surgery** please order your prescriptions by phone or the internet as usual and contact the Reeth Hub (01748 880 021) regarding delivery.

In all cases, food, meals and prescriptions can be collected within the village, or they can still be safely delivered and left outside your door if you are self-isolating or being shielded. Please just ask when you place your order.

#### Keld

The **Hub in Keld remains Butt House** which can be used as a contact and drop off/pick up point. Contact Jacqui & Chris on 01748 886 374

#### Reeth

**The Post Office and Corner Shop** 884 201 is open normal hours for shopping. Post office services are available as normal apart from Thursday morning. The shop will deliver your shopping to the Reeth area. For deliveries further afield please contact the Anchor Hub once you have placed your order and know when it will be ready for collection.

The **Gift Shop** 884 291 is offering a newspaper delivery service in the Reeth area. Newspapers, magazines, milk and eggs can be ordered from The Gift Shop for collection. Milk and eggs are subject to availability and more likely to be guaranteed if you order in advance or request a regular weekly order. The shop is open from 7.30 am to 5.30 pm every day.

The **Two Dales Bakery** is supplying pre-ordered bread to some villages, which are coordinating the order process and delivery. Please check with your village contact.

**Reeth Surgery** please order your prescriptions by phone or the internet as usual. If you would like your prescriptions delivered please contact the Reeth Hub (01748 880 021). The Yellow Community Bus will deliver medicines. Please let the hub know what date you ordered so that they can be collected 48 hours later.

**Reeth Bakery** is opening on a Tuesday, Friday and Saturday 12 noon – 2 pm.

Ramsay's Fish and chips are delivering on a Friday evening – Reeth 4-6 pm; Healaugh 6.20-6.40 pm; Low Row 7-7.20 pm; Gunnerside 7.40-8.10 pm and Usha Gap campsite 8.30 pm. Card payments only no pre-booking needed.

#### **Reeth Market**

The Friday Market reopens on 31 July. Please observe social distancing.

**Beavers Butchers, Masham** On the market from 8 am - 1 pm then in the afternoon home deliveries to Reeth, Arkengarthdale and Swaledale. The delivery van is also a mobile butcher's shop so you could ask them to visit and select from the van.

Orders for *Arkengarthdale* will be delivered on Thursday. Orders up **Swaledale** from *Reeth* to **Muker** will be delivered on a Saturday (Gunnerside orders will be left in Gunnerside Chapel for collection).
